1	60cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior. Team & Individual Height in first round: 60cm
2(S)	70cm Senior Qualifier. Team & Individual Height in first round: 70cm
3(J)	70cm Junior Qualifier. Team & Individual Height in first round: 70cm
4(S)	80cm Senior Qualifier. Team & Individual Height in first round: 80cm
5(J)	80cm Junior Qualifier. Team & Individual Height in first round: 80cm
6	90cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior. Team & Individual Height in first round: 90cm
7	100cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior. Team & Individual Height in first round 100cm
8	105cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior. Team & Individual Height in first round 105cm

- Competitors will only jump any height once and only consecutive classes if doing two.
- Mixed teams can be any combination of juniors and/or seniors.
- A competition pass for the appropriate horse/horses must be valid for every individual/pair/team member entering any qualifier.
- Eligibility is taken from the day of the competition. Anyone failing the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.
- ALL passports not already seen this year or not on the area database MUST be submitted to area18.officialsteward@gmail.com for checking before June 25th at the very latest. HQ has specifically requested we do this to combat the current rise in equine flu cases. The earlier you send it, the greater the chance of identifying and resolving problems.
- NO hand grazing. Please do NOT bring a horse/pony that appears unwell.

This competition will run under BRC Rules. Anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document.

Qualifier format: Two rounds with a jump-off following straight on from the second round, with only competitors who are double clear moving on to the jump-off section. Second round times will be used to resolve ties.

Eligibility criteria can be found on page 52 of the current BRC Handbook. Further SJ info on pp 92, 94 & 95.

Entries and essential information

Please would all clubs provide a helper at the arena side during the time their team(s) compete

Any special requests regarding times must be made to WDRC with your entries and we will do our best to accommodate. Please bear in mind the classes will run in height order, beginning with 60cm. Times will be published on Wednesday, June 24th on Riding Club Results and no changes can be made after this time.

In the event of postponement, we will do our best to reschedule and re-open entries. In the event of cancellation refunds minus unavoidable expenses will be made.

Teams or individuals not wishing to compete at the championships may enter this qualifier HC providing they meet the eligibility criteria. Any team, team member or individual competing HC will not be eligible to compete at the championship.

Late entries may be accepted providing maximum entries have not been received. Applications must be made to the show secretary and a £5 surcharge will apply per horse & rider combination.

Hats

All hats must have a visible current BRC/BE/PC PINK hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground. There will be a trained official available on the day to check and tag hats. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook. Please note that Horse-Events Hat Tags are NOT accepted.

Body Protectors

A body protector is not mandatory for this competition but can be worn.

It is a rider's responsibility to ensure they have the correct standard.

Riders using Exo Body Cages must inform the organiser of the event that they will be using one.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook.

PLEASE NOTE: There is now a system of yellow and red cards. Yellow cards can be issued allowing competitors to compete where the error in their vaccination history does not compromise the welfare of the horse. It is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable. It is an offence to travel your horse to this competition without its passport.

If you do not have a pink sticker on your passport, or the date on the sticker you have will have passed by the date of the competition, please send photographs of the pages required for checking to area18.officialsteward@gmail.com by June 25th at the very latest. The pages required for full checks (horses not already on the database) should show the registered name, microchip (transponder) number and all vaccinations from the most recent two primaries (closest together) to the latest booster. Dates given and vaccine type must be visible. Photos should be the correct way up and high enough resolution to be read clearly. If you are unsure, the sooner you send it in the better – we may have time to get things corrected.

If your horse is already on the area database and you are advising of the latest booster or a re-start, please just include photos of the pages showing the horse's registered name, the booster date or the first two vaccinations of the course as necessary.

You will be able to get a pink sticker from the OS on the day.
