*Horses may compete at two consecutive heights and only twice in the competition (applies to qualifiers and open). See BRC Handbook p90 and updates on BRC website for further info. Worcester will be running open sections for individuals who do not wish to qualify (so no pre-entry). Anyone competing in the qualifier is automatically included as an open competitor and eligible for prize money (subject to entries), provided by WDRRC, as follows:*

**Fastest clear at each height - £30. 2nd - £25. 3<sup>rd</sup> - £20.**

*Those wishing to jump 80 and 90cm may be able to do both on Sunday, depending on entries and light. Please advise if you are entering both and prefer to do this. We will do our best.*

Classes will be run over two rounds. The second round will be 2 phase. The first part may be up to 5cm higher than round 1. The latter part, the jump-off, may be up to 10cm higher than round 1. Only those who have gone double clear will proceed to the jump-off part. Second round times will determine placings for ties.

**This show is being run by volunteers. We have a zero tolerance policy towards abuse and anyone found in breach may incur elimination for their team**

## ENTRIES

All qualifier entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Late pre-entries may be accepted with a late surcharge of £5 per individual and £10 per team (payable to HQ), if space permits. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed so must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details on this schedule.

*Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook.*

**PASSPORTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO [Area18officialsteward@gmail.com](mailto:Area18officialsteward@gmail.com) by October 8<sup>th</sup>** at the latest if they have not been checked this year, or have passed the date on the sticker/had another job. The sooner you send them, the sooner any issues can be spotted. They must be brought to the competition where pink stickers will be available to show they have been checked, along with hat tags. Replacements must be checked on the day.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date, which will be given upon rescheduling.

*If inclement weather necessitates postponement/cancellation, W&DRC will refund entry fees as necessary, minus the payment facility fee.*

*Refunds for individual competitors will only be made on the production of a vet/medical certificate, received by the Entries Secretary no later than October 18th. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee. Please note: the entry fee for a team is the same whether it has 3 or 4 members. Substitutions can be made after entries close, before the competition starts, for emergencies only. Therefore any refund for a team member is up to that member's club, if they are unable to replace the team member.*

## Hats

All hats must have a visible **current** BRC/BE/PC PINK hat tag in place. There will be a trained official on the day to do this. Please note the PINK Horse-Events Hat Tags will NOT be accepted.

## Body Protectors

A body protector is not mandatory but can be worn.

It is a rider's responsibility to ensure they have the correct standard on their body protector.

FEI RESTRICTIONS AS PER CURRENT HANDBOOK

***Eligibility for area qualifiers will be taken from the close of pre-entry. All qualifier competitors must be a member and be on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier (October 11<sup>th</sup>). Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.***

#### DISCLAIMERS

1. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or BRC nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. *Entries are only accepted on this basis.*

2. The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

#### NOTICES

1) Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found so doing will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

2) **INSURANCE:** please ensure that all riders have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

3) The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident and **BEFORE** prize-giving for that class.

4) **PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at the event; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer before you start your round. Photography by Shelley (view online).

5) **HORSES:** Please do not leave horses tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers unsupervised; if horses are known to get distressed when left please ensure there is someone with them at all times.

No haynets to be tied to the outside of lorries/trailers please.

Please do not muck out onto the lorry park and do remove any droppings.
