***Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook (page 91 – please note from September 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 horses may compete in consecutive heights Arena Eventing and Combined Challenge). Eligibility will be taken from the close of pre-entry. All competitors must be a member and be on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.***

#### **Rules and Regulations**

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads/brc-handbook/>

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Pre-entries can be made via the pre-entry website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect>. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual and £20 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits.

**Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details outlined on this schedule.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open.

Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

#### **Helpers**

Formal club helpers will not be required for this event, but there may be a need for ad-hoc help on the day, so it is worth having standby helpers.

#### **Hats**

All hats must have a visible **current** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

#### **Body Protectors**

A body protector is **MANDATORY** for this competition as fixed XC fences will be used.

#### **Flu Vaccinations & Microchips**

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

**There will be no flu vaccination checks on the day. Flu vaccination records will be checked in advance via the Area 18 official stewards. Please email [area18.officialsteward@gmail.com](mailto:area18.officialsteward@gmail.com) with the ID page and all vaccination pages by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 12pm. Random Passport & vaccination checks will take place on the day of competition.**

- Please write clearly on the entry form (excel sheet) if any members have any special requirements i.e early in the class etc. No special requirements will be accepted after the close of entries 20/02/2023.
- **No changes** will be accepted 30 mins before the commencement of the class.
- No major changes will be accepted after **3pm on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023**. Only straight substitutions will be accepted after this time, i.e. name of horse and/or rider taken out and replaced by another. No movements from one team to another will be allowed after this time.
- Times will be available on <https://www.ridingclubresults.co.uk/> Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February from 5pm.
- All classes run under British Riding Club rules.
- The organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever, however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
- Competitors must wear correct dress and hard hats complying with the BRC rules at all times when riding. Tack is the rider's responsibility to ensure they comply with the BRC rules and riders will not compete if not complying.
- The decisions of the judges and/or organisers are final. Any objection must be made to the show secretary in writing before 1300 on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2023, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which may be refunded if complaint is upheld.
- Riding Clubs are respectfully reminded that a preliminary entry means a commitment to pay the area fee. Please note the entry fee for a team is the same whether it has 3 or 4 members. Any refund for a team member is up to that member's club if they are unable to replace the team member.
