This competition will run under BRC Rules. Anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the address below:

Classes will be run over two rounds. The second round will be 2 phase. The first part may be up to 5cm higher than round 1. The latter part, the jump-off, may be up to 10cm higher than round 1. Only those who have gone double clear will proceed to the jump-off part. Second round times will determine placings.

**ROSETTES: Team and individual to sixth place** 

Entries

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £5 per individual or pair and £10 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits.

Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore <u>must not</u> be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the website (link on previous page).

### ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE THROUGH THE WEBSITE WITH IMMEDIATE PAYMENT. <u>NO</u> EMAIL ENTRIES <u>OR</u> BACS PAYMENTS ACCEPTED.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. And as of October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped

PASSPORTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO <u>Area18.officialsteward@gmail.com</u> by April 10<sup>th</sup> if they have not been checked already or have passed the date on the sticker/had another jab. The sooner they are received, the sooner the OS can advise of any issues. <u>They must still be brought to the competition</u> where pink stickers will be available to show they have been checked, along with hat tags. Emergency replacements *must* be checked on the day. The new yellow and red card system will be in operation.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date, which will be given upon rescheduling.

If inclement weather necessitates postponement/cancellation, W&DRC will refund entry fees as necessary, minus the payment facility fee.

Refunds for individual competitors will only be made on the production of a vet/medical certificate, received by the Entries Secretary no later than April 19th. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee. Please note: the entry fee for a team is the same whether it has 3 or 4 members. Substitutions can be made after entries close, before the competition starts, for emergencies only. Therefore, any refund for a team member is up to that member's club, if they are unable to replace the team

member.

Hats

All hats must have a visible **current** BRC/BE/PC PINK hat tag in place. There will be a trained official on the day to do this. Please note the PINK Horse-Events Hat Tags will NOT be accepted.

#### **Body Protectors**

A body protector is not mandatory for this competition but can be worn.

It is a rider's responsibility to ensure they have the correct standard on their body protector.

Riders using Exo Body Cages are allowed to wear those with a purple 2009 BETA level 3 label, however, must inform the organiser of the event that they will be using an Exo Body Cage.

2) INSURANCE: please ensure that all riders have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.3) The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.

4) PHOTOGRAPHS: By entering this competition you agree to be photographed whilst at the event; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer before you start your round. Photography by Shelley (view online).

5) HORSES: Please do not leave horses tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers unsupervised; if horses are known to get distressed when left please ensure there is someone with them at all times.

No hay nets to be tied to the outside of lorries/trailers please.

Please do not muck out onto the lorry park and do remove any droppings.
