Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. Eligibility will be taken from close of pre-entry. All competitors must be a member and be on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- CDRC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
- Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring / show ground – no refund of entry fees will be made
- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
- Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete.
- A child protection trained member of the CDRC committee is available all day – contact the secretary
- Horses must not be left unattended tied to the outside of vehicles. No haynets to be tied to the outside of vehicles
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed
- Directions of any steward or representative of CDRC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge's decision and that of the BRC Official Steward is final. Any objections must be made in accordance with BRC rule G14I.
- [Human] First aid available – contact the secretary
- CDRC, the BHS, BRC and the land owners, accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any horse, vehicles, riders, grooms, spectators etc while in attendance at this event

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Pre-entries can be made via the pre-entry website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect> . Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual and £20 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details outlined on this schedule.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

Hats

All hats must have a visible current BRC/BE/PC **PINK** hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. Please note that the PINK Horse-Events Hat Tags will NOT be accepted. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. Please note for any event with For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

A body protector is not mandatory for this competition but can be worn.

Please note the BETA Level 3 2009 Purple Label is no longer accepted as a recognised standard for Body Protectors at BRC Events. It is a riders responsibility to ensure they have the correct standard of a BETA Level 3 2018 BLUE Label on their body protectors.

Riders using Exo Body Cages are allowed to wear those with a purple 2009 BETA level 3 label, however must inform the organiser of the event that they will be using an Exo Body Cage.

Flu Vaccinations

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

Flu Vaccination records for each horse entered must be emailed to area18.officialsteward@gmail.com NO LATER than 21st October 2023

Numbers to qualify as per Appendix 10 dependant on Appendix 9 in the current BRC Handbook.

Horse Passports MUST be produced, to the Official Steward on the day of the competition
