1	60cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior Team & Individual Height in first round: 60cm
2(S)	70cm Senior Qualifier Team & Individual Height in first round: 70cm
2(J)	70cm Junior Qualifier Team & Individual Height in first round: 70cm
3(S)	80cm Senior Qualifier Team & Individual Height in first round: 80cm
3(J)	80cm Junior Qualifier Team & Individual Height in first round: 80cm
4	90cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior Team & Individual Height in first round: 90cm
5	100cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior Team & Individual Height in first round: 100cm
6	105cm Mixed Qualifier Junior & Senior Team & Individual Height in first round: 105cm

Competitors will only jump any height once and only consecutive classes if doing two. Mixed teams can be any combination of juniors and/or seniors. Eligibility is taken from the close of pre-entry. All competitors must be on the BRC Database by noon the Friday before the qualifier. Anyone failing the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

This competition will run under BRC Rules. Anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document.

Qualifier format: Two rounds with a jump-off following straight on from the second round, with only competitors who are double clear moving on to the jump-off section. Second round times will be used to resolve ties.

Eligibility criteria can be found on pages 88 and 90 of the current BRC Handbook.

Entries

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Pre-entries can be made via the pre-entry website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect> . Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual and £20 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the WDRC website:

Any special requests regarding times must be made to WDRC with your entries and we will do our best to accommodate. Please bear in mind the classes will run in height order, beginning with 60cm. Times will be published on Wednesday, April 9th on Riding Club Results and www.worcsterridingclub.com and no changes can be made after this time.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office (HQ) in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling

Hats

All hats must have a visible **current** BRC/BE/PC PINK hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground. There will be a trained official available on the day to check and tag hats. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook. Please note that Horse-Events Hat Tags are NOT accepted.

Body Protectors

A body protector is not mandatory for this competition but can be worn. It is a rider's responsibility to ensure they have the correct standard of a BETA Level 3 2018 BLUE Label. Riders using Exo Body Cages are allowed to wear those with a purple 2009 BETA level 3 label, however must inform the organiser of the event that they will be using an Exo Body Cage.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook.

PLEASE NOTE: There is now a system of yellow and red cards. Yellow cards can be issued allowing competitors to compete where the error in their vaccination history does not compromise the welfare of the horse. It is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable. It is an offence to travel your horse to this competition without its passport.

If you do not have a pink sticker on your passport, or the date on the sticker you have will have passed by the date of the competition, please send photographs of the pages required for checking to area18.officialsteward@gmail.com by April 9th at the very latest.

If your horse is already on the area database and you are advising of the latest booster or a re-start, please just include photos of the pages showing the horse's registered name, the booster date or the first two vaccinations of the course as necessary.

If your horse is not on the database please send photos of the pages showing registered name, description, microchip (transponder) number, the first two vaccinations of the course and all boosters. You will be able to get a sticker from the OS on the day or will be advised of the possibilities open to resolve a problem.

PLEASE NOTE: We are not able to see the dates of the vaccinations so make sure your photos show them – not just partly. Please email the photos at high enough resolution to be read so if your phone gives you options please don't choose 'small'. And please try not to send them upside down!

The earlier you send them, the earlier any issues can be sorted out.
