It is the team managers' and competitors' responsibility to ensure they and their horses are eligible for these classes and are aware of all relevant rules regarding the competition, tack and turnout etc. These rules are available online in the BRC Handbook 2022 and subsequent amendments.

Vaccinations must be correct in accordance with BRC rules (no longer required 6-monthly)

SATURDAY October 15th

CLASS ONE: 70 SEIB Winter Novice (maximum height in round 1 - 70cm)

- A: Senior Teams
- B: Senior Individuals
- C: Junior Teams
- D: Junior Individuals

CLASS TWO: 80 SEIB Winter Novice (maximum height in round 1 – 80cm)

- A: Senior Teams
- B: Senior Individuals
- C: Junior Teams
- D: Junior Individuals

CLASS THREE: 90 Horsehage & Mollichaff Winter Intermediate (maximum height in round 1 - 90cm) *FOR THOSE DOING THE 80CM*

- A: Senior teams
- B: Senior Individuals - results on Sunday
- C: Junior teams
- D: Junior Individuals - results on Sunday



This class is open on Saturday to individual horse and rider combinations and teams that are also competing at 80, so they do not have to travel both days. The rest of the 90 (and anyone who can't make Saturday, providing they let us know well in advance) will be on Sunday October 16th.

SUNDAY October 16th

CLASS FOUR: 90 Horsehage & Mollichaff Winter Intermediate (max height in round 1 - 90cm)

Note: Final results will include scores of competitors from the previous day.

- B: Senior Individuals
- C: Junior Teams
- D: Junior Individuals

CLASS FIVE: 100 Horsehage & Mollichaff Winter Intermediate (maximum height in round 1 - 1m)

Mixed class open to senior and junior individuals, and teams any combination of senior and/or junior.

- A: Teams
- B: Individuals

CLASS SIX: 110 Horsehage & Mollichaff Winter Intermediate (maximum height in round 1 - 1m10)

Mixed class open to senior and junior individuals, and teams any combination of senior and/or junior.

- A: Teams
- B: Individuals

Horses may compete at consecutive heights in teams at each height or as an individual. Horses may only compete twice. Juniors and seniors may share horses subject to the provisos on pages 94&95 of the BRC Handbook 2022.

Classes will be run over two rounds (Option 3). The second round will be 2 phase. The first part may be up to 5cm higher than round 1. The latter part, the jump-off, may be up to 10cm higher than round 1. Only those who have gone double clear will proceed to the jump-off part. Second round times will determine placings.

TEAM MANAGERS PLEASE NOTE:

Team managers should let the official steward know on the day of competition if they are aware that any competitor **can not** go to the championship. The qualification can then be passed down the line.

DISCLAIMERS

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or BRC nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this basis.**
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND NOTICES

- 1) Refunds for individual competitors will only be made on the production of a vet/medical certificate, received by the Entries Secretary no later than October 18th. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee. Please note: the entry fee for a team is the same whether it has 3 or 4 members. Substitutions can be made after entries close, before the competition starts, for emergencies only. Therefore any refund for a team member is up to that member's club, if they are unable to replace the team member.
- 2) Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found so doing will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
- 3) INSURANCE: please ensure that all riders have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 4) The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident and BEFORE prize-giving for that class.
- 5) PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at the event; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer before you start your round.
- 6) HORSES: Please do not leave horses tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers unsupervised; if horses are known to get distressed when left on trailers/lorries, please ensure that there is someone with them at all times. No haynets to be tied to the outside of lorries/trailers please. Please do not muck out onto the lorry park and do remove any droppings.
- 7) DOGS – not permitted.
- 8) Hat Tagging – please make sure that your riding hat has the correct BRC/BE/PC turquoise hat tag. If not your hat will need to be presented to an official steward for inspection and tagging. Horse Events hat tags are NOT valid for BRC.
- 9) Drawn Orders – will be adhered to - if you arrive late for your round you will possibly have to wait to the end of the class and will only be allowed to jump if there is time. Please be ready well before your estimated time.
- 10) Any rider attending the event on their own MUST give an emergency contact name and phone number to the Show Secretary.
- 11) All entries to Worcester & District Riding Club must be made either online or with a Riding Club cheque.
