No rosettes or results will be given on the day. Once you have competed, please leave the venue.

Rules and Regulations

- Horses to be flu vaccinated and be within the 12 month booster.
- The Judges decision is final.
- Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted conforming to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 Standard.
- All classes are run under British Dressage Rules.
- No Horse/Pony under four years old.
- Stallions by appointment.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- No Galloping or Lunging allowed on the showground.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any class and reserve the right to alter the schedule and to close or cancel classes.
- Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and may not be carried forward.

Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
