

MHRC Pepper Pot League

RULES: v2 UPDATED December 2017

- The league is open to all FULL riding members of MHRC and is automatically calculated.
- SUPPORTER members may earn points at the discretion of the committee.
- Points are awarded to the HORSE and RIDER combination. Members may earn points riding different horses, but their points will remain separate.
- Where possible, points can be earned at competitions run from 1st January to 31st December in any year. However, due to time constraints, competitions run in the latter half of December may be transferred to the following year to allow for prizes to be ordered in time for the presentation evening.
- Rosettes and Trophies are awarded at the AGM.
- Trophies MUST be returned when requested for preparation for the following year.

HOW TO EARN POINTS

- Points can be earned by competing in Mercian competitions, Area qualifiers, BRC Championships, Inter-dressage or in other events where the member is asked to represent MHRC.
- Points are also earned when entering competitions organised by MHRC.
- 5 points are awarded for entry, regardless of result.
- For INDIVIDUAL places, the following points are awarded: 1st = 35, 2nd = 30, 3rd = 25, 4th = 20, 5th = 15, 6th = 10, Any other place that is awarded a rosette at the competition = 5.
- Any member of a placed TEAM is awarded the following points: 1st = 35, 2nd = 30, 3rd = 25, 4th = 20, 5th = 15, 6th = 10. These points are awarded to ALL members of the team who competed on the day, even if the individual is disqualified or is the discount score.

PRIZES

POINTS LEAGUE

- The overall points league is split into Junior and Senior members.
- Rosettes are awarded to 15th place in both sections.

OVERALL TROPHY

- A Perpetual trophy is awarded to the Overall League Champion - this is the Horse and Rider combination earning the most points, irrespective of whether Junior or Senior.

DRESSAGE TROPHY NEW FOR 2017

- A Perpetual trophy is awarded to both the Junior and Senior member gaining the most points in Dressage competitions.
- Points for this award can be earned at Dressage, Dressage to Music and Riding Test competitions.

JUMPING TROPHY NEW FOR 2018

- A Perpetual trophy is awarded to both the Junior and Senior member gaining the most points in Jumping competitions.
- Points for this award can be earned at Show Jumping, Style Jumping, Hunter Trials or any other competitions that involve one round of jumping, whether over knock-down fences or permanent fences.

COMBINED TROPHY NEW FOR 2018

- A Perpetual trophy is awarded to both the Junior and Senior member gaining the most points in Combined competitions.
- Points for this award can be earned at Combined Training, One-Day-Events, Horse Trials, Eventer Challenges or any other competitions that involve more than one discipline.
